### Medication in School

Please make sure that if your child took their asthma inhaler home at the end of last term, you have returned it to reception and completed a new medication form.



If your child needs to take prescription medication during the school day, this must be brought in (in its original container bearing the name of the person for whom it has been prescribed) by an adult and a 'Medication in School' form completed. We will be unable to administer any medicines or tablets unless this procedure is followed. Most of our parents are excellent at following this practice, but there have been times when children have arrived at school with bottles of medicine or tablets in their school bags.

New Children: If your child has just started with us and you have not already done so, please inform us of any medical problems that may affect your child in school, and also ensure that if your child is asthmatic, we have a pump for him/her if necessary. Thank you.

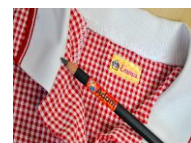
## PE Kit
